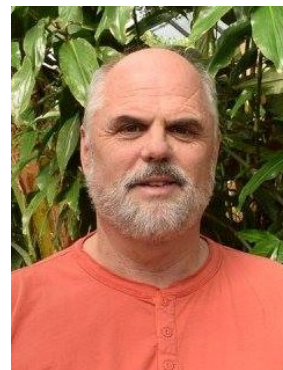


MEET THE BAND: DUSTY RHODES AND THE RAMBLERS
